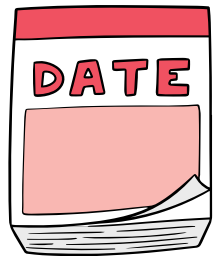

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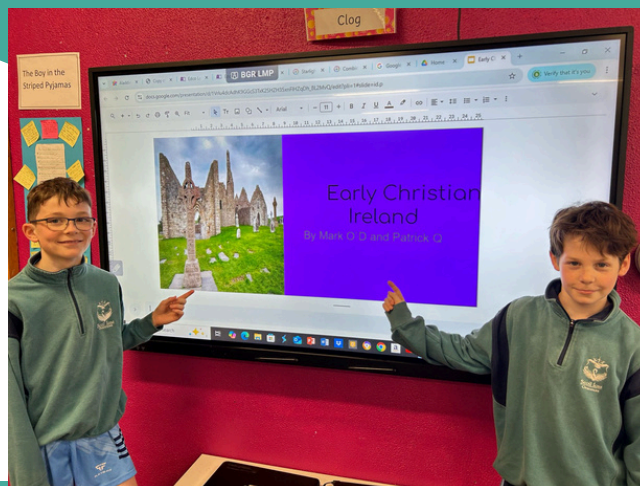
MS. COLLERAN'S FIFTH CLASS UPDATE

*Students engaged in research and enjoyed presenting their projects prior to the 5th Class Field Trip to The Burren.

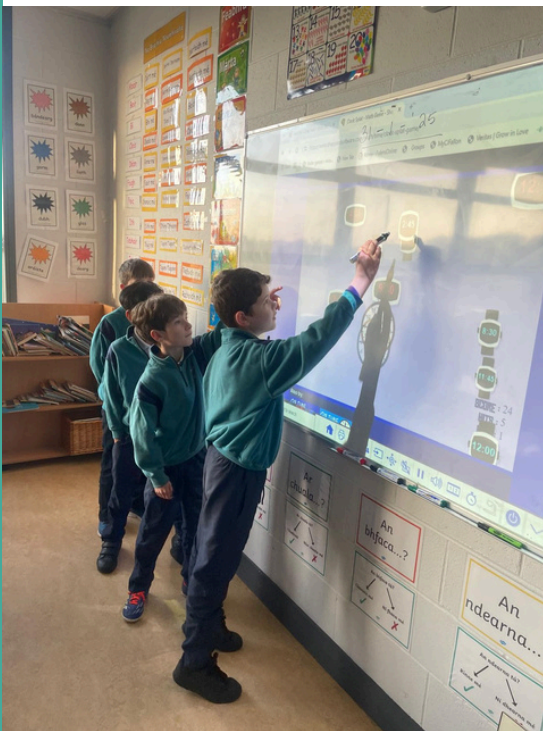
